Dr. Anita Mixon

Received her doctoral degree in Communication from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign where she specialized in Rhetoric and minored in Gender and Women's Studies. Her research examines institutional rhetoric via the intersections of race, gender, and identity-formation in urban enclaves. Her dissertation, "Women Speaking in and for Institutions: A Rhetorical History of the Politics of Respectability in Black Chicago, 1919-1939," explored the early twentieth century Chicago urban enclave, Bronzeville. She interrogated the ways in which Black women utilized agency, decorum, and respectability politics to navigate the church and labor.
